Study Room General Guidelines

The Bradford West Gwillimbury Public Library strives to provide a welcoming and comfortable environment for all our Library users.

The guidelines listed below are meant to help all our users understand the expectations for Study Room use to ensure a pleasant experience for all Library visitors.

- Study rooms are available for free to individuals only for the purposes of quiet activities, including research, studying, and reading. Study rooms may not be used for commercial sales, solicitations, promotions, gambling, or horseplay.
- Study rooms are limited to three or four occupants at a time (see chart below).
- Users are responsible for leaving the room in a neat and orderly condition. Failure to do so may result in the denial of future requests. The Library reserves the right to charge users for any damage or clean-up expenses.
- The Library accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen property.
- **Rooms can be reserved up to 48 hours in advance, one reservation per day for up to four hours, per individual or group.**
- Rooms must be claimed within 10 minutes of the start time, or the reservation will be cancelled, and the room made available to others.
