Study Room General Guidelines

The Bradford West Gwillimbury Public Library strives to provide a welcoming and comfortable environment. The guidelines listed below are meant to help users understand the expectations for Study Room use to ensure a pleasant experience for all visitors.

- Study rooms are available for free to individuals only for the purposes of quiet activities, including research, studying, and reading. Study rooms may not be used for commercial sales, solicitations, promotions, gambling, or horseplay.
- Study rooms have limited capacity. (See table)
- Neither the Calder room nor the Blair room are available for public use currently.
- Users are responsible for leaving the room in a neat and orderly condition. Failure to do so may result in the denial of future requests. The Library reserves the right to charge users for any damage or clean-up expenses.
- The Library accepts no responsibility for lost or stolen property.
- Rooms can be reserved up to 48 hours in advance, for up to **three hours** per day, per individual or group.
- Occupants may continue to use a room beyond the three hours if there are no reservations and no one is waiting.
- Rooms must be claimed within 10 minutes of the start time, or it will be cancelled, and the room made available to others.
